- Were you already familiar with our company before you applied?
- Why do you want to work for our company?
- How well do you know our products and services?
- What would you change about our company?
- What do you think makes us different from our competitors?
- What interests you most about this position?

- Why do you want to leave your current job?
- In your current or previous role, what were you responsible for?
- What projects did you enjoy working on the most?
- What kind of projects did you not enjoy?

### Questions About Teamwork

- What kind of people do you most enjoy working with?
- What kind of people do you not enjoy working with?
- What makes you a team player?
- What does teamwork mean to you?
- Do you enjoy working independently?
- Can you give us an example of when you lead people and delegated tasks?

### Questions About Attitude

- What motivates you most?
- Where do you see yourself in five years? Ten years?
- How do you feel about business travel?
- How do you feel about working overtime?

### Questions That Can Throw You Off

- Why should we hire you out of all our candidates?
- Have you applied anywhere else?
- What other companies are you interviewing with?
- What is your current salary?
